Draft - Allotment allocation and rent policy

- 1. The policy of WPC is, as a minimum, to cover all costs of the Parish Council providing allotments, including but not limited to land rent, administrative costs, and any water costs for which the Parish Council is liable
- 2. The allotment rents for the fiscal year 19/20 (1st April 2019 to 30th March 2020) are: (subject to approval at November 18 WPC meeting)
 - i. 1 plot £14 per annum
 - ii. 1/2 plot £10 per annum
 - iii. 1/4 plot £7 per annum
- 3. Water costs for water are not included in the above rent. The meter will be read at the end of the season and retrospectively charged to tenants on a pro-rata basis
- 4. Rents will be reviewed annually as part of the normal budget cycle of WPC
- 5. All rents are collected annually in advance and are collected in alignment with the council's fiscal year
- 6. Allocation of allotments will be at the start of each fiscal year and preference will be in the following order:
 - a. Current tenants to continue with their existing plot
 - b. Current tenants to switch plots with another allotment holder by mutual agreement
 - c. Current tenants to switch to a vacant plot instead of their existing one, once all other current tenants have been allocated plots.
 - d. Any Walberswick residents wanting a plot
 - e. Others wanting a plot
- 7. Plot allocation cannot gifted, bequeathed, sold or in any other way passed on to others by allotment holders outside of the mechanism laid out above
- 8. In circumstances where there is a waiting list for plots, this will be maintained by the Walberswick Parish Clerk
- 9. Walberswick Parish Council reserves the right to terminate the use of one, more than one or all on provision of 12 months' notice to existing tenants
- 10. All allotment holders must sign a valid (i.e. current version) tenancy agreement before taking up their tenancy the current agreement can be viewed here (link to be inserted)
