Discussion paper following survey of Commemorative Benches in the village

- Attached to this paper are the results of the recently conducted (August 19) survey by the WPC Safety Committee of all the Commemorative Benches identified.
- The following proposals are recommended for adoption by WPC:
 - Update the WPC asset register to reflect the value and number of the identified "stock" of benches retained in WPC control
 - For the two benches identified as being very poor condition:
 - Removal of the benches is undertaken in the short-term on safety grounds.
 - Attempts are then made to identify anyone who may be willing to fund a continuation of a replacement bench to the same people, in line with the WPC policy on Commemorative donations.
 - $\circ~$ For the two benches requiring repair
 - Authorise this repair to be carried out
 - For all benches in WPC control:
 - Undertake an annual re-survey of condition
 - Attempt to identify "sponsors" for each of the benches and record them on a central database
 - Undertake a regular maintenance schedule, including staining/treating with a preservative to extend life and ensure safety.
