Football Goals on the common


Dear Clerk,

The goals on wheels are easy to move when needed and keep the net out of the way, obviously more expensive.

For the fixed goal the net will need tying back and will need a to be concreted in. However they should be movable if set correctly.

I'm not sure they would get anymore use than the current goals and the goal next to the fence is a bit of a pain as the balls keep flying into the gorse behind it and getting punctured, so I would hope if you are replacing only one it would be the one next to the path across the common.
