OUR ONLY CHANNEL OF COMMUNICATION WITH OUR MEMBERS WAS BY PUBLISHING AND DISTRIBUTING 9 X "LOCKDOWN" ISSUES OF THE NEWSLETTER – OUR THANKS GO ESPECIALLY TO JOHN ENGLISH AND TO HIS CONTRIBUTORS FOR THEIR DEDICATION AND SUPPORT.

THE LOCKDOWN ALSO SAW THE REVOVATION OF THE HERITAGE HUT ON THE GREEN. THIS WAS DUE TO THE DEDICATION OF THE COMMON LANDS TRUST, PARISH COUNCIL, SCROLL GROUP AND OUR ARCHIVIST, PAT LANCASTER. AS A RESULT, ALL THE ARCHIVES HAVE BEEN MOVED FROM HER HOME TO THE HERITAGE HUT. THIS IS A MAJOR ACHIEVEMENT AND BODES WELL FOR THE FUTURE. IT IS GOOD TO KNOW THAT ALL THE ARCHIVES REMAIN IN THE VILLAGE.
