The RNLI provides a 24-hour search and rescue service around the UK and Ireland up to 100 nautical miles offshore. It has 238 operational lifeboat stations, 458 lifeboats (including relief fleet) and employs 1500 lifeguards covering 240 beaches around the coastline. In 2020 lifeboats were launched 8,239 times, aided 8,374 people of which 239 lives were saved.

After many years as Treasurer on the committee Robin Buncombe decided it was time to stand down from this role although happily has agreed to remain on the committee. We would like to sincerely thank Robin for his excellent management of our finances in recent years
