13. MATTERS RAISED BY MEMBERS

- a. **Horses being ridden on sand dunes** – Councillor Aldridge reported that there was evidence of horses being ridden on the sand dunes. As the person/persons had not been identified it was agreed to place a notice in the Village News reminding people that this was an offence under The Land Drainage and Sea Defence Byelaws.
- b. **Severe drop of the bank of the Dunwich River** – Councillor K Webb reported that this had happened down by the harbour and could prove dangerous. As work was already being carried out in the area erecting landing stages, it was agreed to approach the contractors asking if they would be prepared to carry out the required work to make the area safer.
- c. **Pothole in the road** – Councillor Tibbles reported that there was a pothole in the road outside Vine Cottage. Agreed to report this to the Highways Department.
- d. **Chestnut fencing** – Councillor Buncombe reported that a dog had been rescued from the river having jumped over the harbour wall. Agreed to report this to Waveney District Council
- e. **Safer Neighbourhood Meeting at Stratford St. Andrew** – Councillor D Webb reported that a meeting was taking place on Wednesday 7th January but most of the points on the agenda were not relevant to Walberswick.
- f. **Posts on Village Green outside tea rooms** – Two more posts were required to stop vehicle exiting the track via the Green. Councillor Aldridge agreed to purchase the posts and Councillor K Webb agreed to concrete them in place.
