

April 2026:

Tucked away behind The Street is a piece of WCLC land called Bennett's Copse. It is a beautiful glade in spring, and in early March the National Landscape Volunteers came into the Village to carry out a series of stewardship tasks. The organisation is part funded by the Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs and part by Suffolk County Council and its remit is to enhance and protect areas of outstanding natural beauty; this includes a volunteer action group which is out many weeks of the year.

On a classic bright spring day, it was a real pleasure to be in Bennett's Copse where the volunteers cleared and laid a glade footpath, planted 180 native species hedging plants and nine young oak trees, completed a tree survey, and constructed and put up four bird boxes.
