BANKS John snr., a widowed tailor from Bramfield, married Mary Maggs, the daughter of Ann Maggs, née Snell, the widow of Thomas Maggs, the landlord of the "Blue Anchor" in Walberswick, who died there on 31.7.1799. His tombstone can still be seen there in the local churchyard, near the road.

The widowed Ann Maggs handed over the tenancy of the inn to her son-in-law John Banks snr., who accidentally drowned on the 24.10.1824 in a well at Benhall at night on his way back from Wickham Market. His widow, Mary, took over the tenancy of the "Blue Anchor" until the 1.3.1827, when Mr. William Easey became its landlord.

On the 23.11.1831 the widowed Mary Banks married Mr. Edward Cotes, a farmer of Brundish and she died on the 18.8.1859, aged 75 at her son-in-law, Amos Barber of Southwold and was interred in Walberswick. Her daughter, Mary Ann Banks b.1803, married Amos Barber on the 6.9.1830 in Walberswick. MD

BANKS John jnr., shoemaker from High Str, Bramfield, moved with his family from London to Walberswick in 1840. In 1871 he was living alone in High Str. Probably his wife had died between 1861-1871. He still lived there in 1881.
