

The family history of the Rev. Charles Edward Grayson PICKTHALL, rector of Chillesford father of Caroline Louisa PICKTHALL, the authoress of "Ferry Knoll" and who lived and died in Walberswick in Dec. 1925. See register page 69.

The Rev. Charles Edward Grayson PICKTHALL was rector of Chillesford from January 1857, may be earlier, because from July 1853 the parish was served by a succession of curates and officiating ministers who have been deputising for him, and he continued as rector until mid 1877, may be longer because once again there was a succession of officiating ministers until the new rector was appointed in or around March 1882.

The Rev. Charles Edward Grayson PICKTHALL and his wife Ellen Louisa had the following children christened at Chillesford:

Although baptised as Grace Pickthall it would seem their last daughter also used the the name Maud Navine Pickthall when she was living in a small cottage in The Street, Chillesford, as shown in a Poor Rate book of November 1924. Grace Pickthall was a local watercolourist with some skill, one of her paintings hangs in Wantisden Church.

Charles Edward (born 18.Oct.1864) died 26. Jan.1928 aged 63 and was buried on 28.Jan. 1928 at Chillesford. He was residing at Tattingstone House, Tattingstone near Ipswich.

The Rev. Charles Edward Grayson PICKTHALL was an associate of Richard Wallace who inherited the Sudbourn Estate from his natural father The Marquis of Hertford.

The big picture of an Estate shooting party,hung in the Orford Town Hall, shows both men (with others).

It was the Rev. Pickthall who had the Chillesford Rectory built (now the Old Rectory) on a higher site opposite the old Tudor "parsonage" and glebe lands,upon which he also built a school of two classrooms, school teacher's house and a laundry.

The west window of Chillesford parish church is in memory of the Rev. Charles Grayson PICKTHALL and Louise PICKTHALL but gives no dates. The former east window (destroyed some years ago) bore the inscription:

"In Memoriam Petri Christie Patris Sui/ Dilectissimi Qui Obiit Prima Die Martii
A D 1865 / Aetat 73 Hanc Fenestram Pia Filia Erexit."

Peter Christie was the patron of the living but I have no proof whether Ellen Louisa Pickthall was the "pia filia".
